Associate Professor at the University of Athens and Visiting Professor in Practice at the London School of Economics and Political Science with extensive experience in academia and policy relevant research. He has worked on financial systems, corporate investment, and innovation dynamics with financial support from international institutions and continuous interaction with Multilateral Development Banks, the European Union and UN agencies. He is a former EBRD Board Member and served as Chair of the Audit Committee, Chair of the European Union coordination group and member of the Retirement Plan Investment Committee. During his tenure at the EBRD, he was involved in all high-level decision-making processes, from country strategies to investment project, including the approval and the modalities of EBRD's engagement in Greece. In his role as knowledge manager, he has coordinated international research teams and benefitted from the interaction with policy makers and the business community, especially when it comes to project structuring and the evolving dynamics of capital markets and innovation. During his tenure, the EBRD Investments in Greece reached record levels with 4,360 million euro in 67 projects and a pipeline of 890 million euro in 19 projects. Mr. Bartzokas was born in 1962.
