1. The calculation of direct greenhouse gas emissions (SCOPE 1) is performed using energy conversion factors from fuel consumption (in TJ) to carbon dioxide equivalents (CO₂e). The numbers at the end of the reference period (year 2020) are used. The NIR 2020 methodology has been used for the values of the conversion factors.
2. The calculation of indirect greenhouse gas emissions (SCOPE 2) is performed using conversion factors of energy from consumption electricity, heating, cooling, and steam (in TJ) to carbon dioxide equivalents (CO₂eq). The numbers at the end of the reference period (year 2020) are used. The European Residual Mix 2019 methodology has been used for the values of the conversion factors.
3. A preliminary estimation of the scope 3 according to EIB Project Carbon Footprint Methodologies (July 2020) from the LCA study is at the level of 0.358 t CO₂/t Al ingot. The calculation of the scope 3 according to Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Protocol Standard is in progress.
4. The difference between the total amount of water withdrawals and the total amount of water discharges.
